<u>1st Vice Commander Report</u>

There is a correction to last month's report. There was a misprint about the app used for signing up new members. Instead of the Legion app, it should have been Legion Plus app (Legion with a plus sign).

While Paid Up For Life (PUFL) membership is beneficial to both our Post and the member, it is financially not feasible for many people. While it is considerably expensive, the member never has to pay dues again.

There is another option available. When renewing online, you have the option of renewing for three years. This option serves you, the member, in a couple of ways.

First: If National, State or the Post raise their portion of the dues in the next three years, you are already paid at the lower rate. You will not be charged the higher rate until you renew again after your expiration time.

Second: You will not receive all the renewal notices that National sends out until the end of your renewal period. This saves National funds in mailing costs and saves you from receiving multiple renewal notices.

The three-year option also serves the local Post. When renewals begin each July, our percentage of renewals is already higher. This gives us a head start on membership for the year. Also, if dues go up during this period, the Post still receives the same amount of their share for the remainder of the three-year period.

All of this being said, consider this as an option when you renew. But more importantly, renew soon. Not only so we can reach our membership goals, but so we can keep you as an integral part of Post 593.

Lastly, I wish all of you a happy and memorable holiday season.

FLAGS

It is always wonderful to see our US flag flying on a clear day. You may remember (see the August 2024 Post 593 Newsletter) we presented a US and Texas flag to the new Honor Elementary School in Converse, TX. When the school opened in August, I went to the school, talked to the new flag patrol team about handling and folding the flag and then we raised the flags (see photos). It was

an exciting and eventful day for the students. Another flag event occurred on Veterans Day, November 11th. Our Post 593 has continued the decades-long ceremony, previously conducted by the Windcrest Post 612, of placing a US flag on the graves of veterans buried in the Bueche Cemetery located on Crestway Drive in Windcrest, TX. Some background information: the Bueche Cemetery is a Bexar County Historical Cemetery and dates back to the late 1800s as a family cemetery of early settlers in the northeast San Antonio area. It is an actively operated cemetery. Currently there are twenty veteran graves including several Civil War veterans and graves of veterans from all services. The picture below shows me placing a flag on the grave of Eugene Leonhardt, a WW II veteran; we believe the Leonhardts are related back in Germany many years ago. Lastly, as a small Post 593 fund-raising project, I have US and Texas flags, nylon, 3'x5', from the American Legion Store for sale at \$27 US flag and \$28 Texas flag. 
